Children & Youth Growth Opportunities

Infants - 3 year olds - Kingdom Care:

Where: WSN Butterfly & Infant/Toddler rooms

Kingdom Care is a safe and loving place for our youngest children. Those who are able will engage in play, hear a Bible Story, worship, and do a simple activity each evening.

4 year olds - 1st Grade Class:

Where: WSN Sonshine Room

This class will engage in hands-on activities, worship, explore God's Bible Stories, memorize God's Word, have time to play together, and have intentional fellowship activities.

2nd - 5th Grade Class:

Where: WSN Fellowship Hall

This class will play games together, explore new worship skills, dig into God's Word, be challenged to memorize God's Word each week, and engage in intentional fellowship activities.

Mid-High - BASIC:

Following Jesus involves movement - living and walking with Him in the company of others. As followers, He invites us to take "next steps" in faith. We will survey and explore "next steps" beneficial to Christians across centuries as they have followed Jesus across the varying seasons of their lives. The aim is to nurture your cooperation with Him as His Spirit works to form Christ in you and to deepen your participation in Jesus' life with the Father and in His ministry to the world. Beneficial practices such as Spiritual reading of Scripture and Christian classics, abiding prayer, Ignatian Exercises, Sabbath-keeping, and communal discernment of calling will be introduced. *Familiarity with the book Mansions of the Heart is beneficial, but not a prerequisite.*
